HISTORIC WACO FOUNDATION TO HOST “ART IN CAMERON PARK – YESTERDAY AND TODAY” EXHIBIT!

The Waco Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) is pleased to announce that the Historic Waco Foundation will be the host to “Art in Cameron Park – Yesterday and Today”, which will take place at East Terrace, 101 Mill Street, from Sunday, May 16 through July 4. The exhibit spans more than 100 years and features 22 oil, acrylic and watercolor paintings from local artists, as well as a slideshow of more than 200 digital images of life in Cameron Park by Waco photographer Don Castello.
